Mathematics: Place Value: Children will recognise the place value of each digit in a 4 digit number. They will order and compare numbers beyond 1,000 and round numbers to the nearest 1,000. They will begin to read Roman numerals up to 1,000 and count backwards past 0.

Addition and Subtraction: Children will use formal methods to add and subtract 4 digit numbers. They will begin to estimate and check their answers using inverse calculations

R.E./P.S.H.E:
