Properties and changes of materials

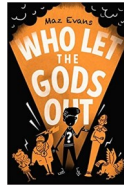
- Planning different types of scientific enquiries to answer questions, including recognising and controlling variables where necessary

- We will also explore the values of 'Determination'.

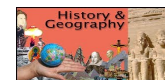


History/ Geography :
