Looking at toys from the past



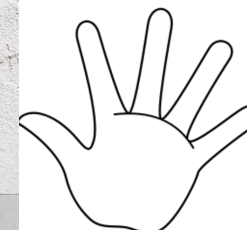
Physical Development: Fine and gross motor skills

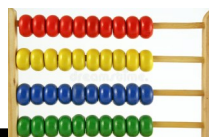
Mathematics

Learning about addition and subtraction (5+1) (10-4)

Ordering objects by size and length

Use language related to time (Before, after, past, o'clock, morning, afternoon, evening)

Subitising (Counting objects without pointing to each individual object)



Book: Cinderella

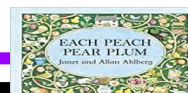
Genre: Fiction

Others Stories: Grandad's Island/The tiger who came to tea

Enquiry question: Do you have memories from the past ?

Project: Long Ago (Stories and Rhymes)

Books: Each, peach, pear, plum/
Room on the broom



Communication and Language:

Listens to familiar stories and recall parts of the story

Discuss the beginning, middle and end of a story

Answer how and why questions, linked to stories. How did Cinderella feel? Why did the tiger eat all of the food? Why was Syd sad?

Learning new rhymes, poems and songs

Making a picnic for The tiger who came to tea



Expressive Arts:

Use movement to express feelings. How did Syd travel on the boat?

Using imagination to create transport pictures

Making toys using junk modelling materials

Experiment with musical instruments. Joining in with repeated words from the stories

Design and make an island for Syd and Grandad

Role play linked to the class project. A café for the tiger to visit

Literacy:

Writing instructions for how to prepare a picnic

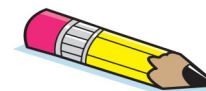
Looking at different shopping lists and food labels
