

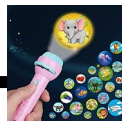
### How you can help at home:

Explore 2D flat shapes (Sides, flat, round, straight)

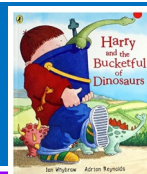
Begin to describe a familiar route (Travelling to school)

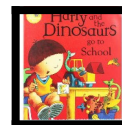
**Book:** Harry and his bucketful of dinosaurs/Harry and his bucketful of dinosaurs go to school

Painting rainbows using different colours



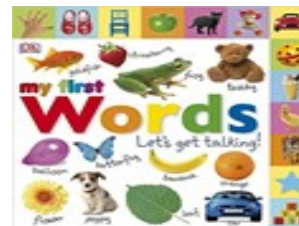
### Literacy:
