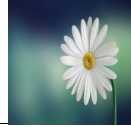
Understanding The World:

Developing an awareness of different seasons

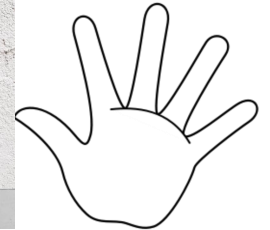


Physical Development: Fine and gross motor skills

Learning about odd numbers (1, 3, 5, 7, 9)

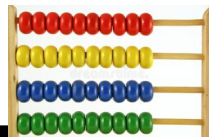
Learning about even numbers (2, 4, 6, 8, 10)

Ordering objects by size and length

Counting in 10's and 5's

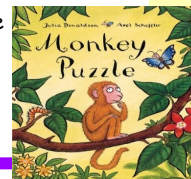
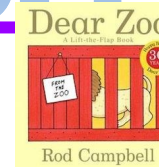
Book: Monkey Puzzle, Walking through the jungle, Dear zoo

Genre: Fiction

Others Stories: Doing the animal bop

Enquiry question: What adventures will you have in the summer?

Project: Animal Safari (Creep, crawl and wiggle)



Communication and Language:

Listens to familiar stories and recall parts of the story

Use new vocabulary throughout the day

Discuss the beginning, middle and end of a story

Answer how and why questions, linked to stories. How did the animals move around the jungle? What do the different animals eat?

Learning new rhymes, poems and songs

Asking questions about the environment and plants

Expressive Arts:

Using imagination to create jungle, rainforest and zoo pictures

Making animal models using junk modelling materials

Role play linked to the story of the week

Making animal masks

Using construction materials to design and build a zoo and jungle

Literacy:

Writing instructions for how to travel to the zoo

Looking at a range of fiction and non-fiction books in the school library

Writing a letter to the zoo

Recognise some tricky and high frequency words

Writing words and sentences linked to different environments
