

### Science

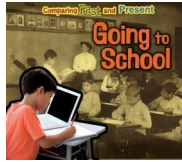
Children will be continuing their learning on materials and exploring which materials are suitable for their purpose and why. Children will also look into seasonal changes and what changes we notice in Summer.

### Home Learning

### Mathematics

This term year 1 will focus on: Fractions, Time and Place value within 100.

- Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Finding a half and a quarter.
- Reading, writing and representing numbers to 100.
- Exploring time and learning to read the time to the hour.
- Position and direction



### Art/DT/Music

In D.T the children will explore various ways of preparing foods including slicing, grating and cutting. Children will then prepare a Victorian dish using their knowledge of Victorian Era foods.



### R.E./ PHSE
