

Literacy	<p>Writing instructions for how to prepare a picnic</p> <p>Looking at different shopping lists and food labels</p> <p>Writing a recipe for making cakes</p> <p>Recognise some harder to read and spell words</p> <p>Writing words and sentences linked to toys from the past</p>

Maths	<p>Learning about addition and subtraction (5+1) (10-4)</p> <p>Ordering objects by size and length</p> <p>Use language related to time (Before, after, past, o'clock, morning, afternoon, evening)</p> <p>Subitising (Counting objects without pointing to each individual object)</p>
Communication and Language	<p>Listens to familiar stories and recall parts of the story</p> <p>Discuss the beginning, middle and end of a story</p> <p>Answer how and why questions, linked to stories. How did Cinderella feel? Why was Grandma upset? Why was Syd sad?</p> <p>Learning new rhymes, poems and songs</p> <p>Use new vocabulary throughout the day</p>
Expressive Arts and Design	<p>Use movement to express feelings. How did Syd travel on the boat?</p> <p>Using imagination to create transport pictures</p> <p>Make and design a basket for Grandma</p>

	<p>Experiment with musical instruments</p> <p>Design and make an island for Syd and Grandad</p>
Understanding of the World	<p>Visit to the local library and learning about different occupations</p> <p>Discussing different seasons and changes</p> <p>Drawing a map to help Cinderella travel safely to the ball</p> <p>Looking at photographs from the past (Baby photographs)</p>
PE	<p>Experiment with different ways of moving during PE sessions</p> <p>Form some recognisable upper and lower case letters</p> <p>Using cutlery correctly</p> <p>Using scissors to cut out a shape</p>
Key Vocabulary	<p>Past, Now, Before</p> <p>Long ago, Photographs</p> <p>Time</p> <p>Change</p> <p>Beginning, middle, end</p> <p>Help</p> <p>Job, together, kind</p> <p>First, second, third</p>
