


Write a short sentence with known grapheme and phoneme correspondence

Understanding of the World	<p>Discuss a range of animals and their babies</p> <p>Talk about which animals lay eggs</p> <p>Explore different animals that come from eggs</p> <p>Discussing different seasons and changes</p> <p>Discuss the perfect conditions needed for plants to grow (Cress seeds)</p> <p>Discuss animal habitats and where different animals live (Farm, zoo, wild, stables, ocean, ponds etc)</p> <p>Talk about why a mosque is a special place</p>

	<p>Draw a picture of a mosque and discuss their own experiences</p> <p>Discussing different environments and countries</p> <p>Exploring the natural world</p>
PE	<p>Experiment with different ways of moving during PE sessions (Rolling, crawling, walking, jumping, skipping)</p> <p>Using scissors to cut out different sized shapes</p> <p>Develop ball skills (Throwing, catching, kicking, passing, batting and aiming skills)</p> <p>Form some recognisable upper- and lower-case letters</p> <p>Using cutlery correctly</p> <p>Using scissors to cut out a shape</p> <p>Thread wool/ string through holes to create a pattern</p>
